

- Context is everything
- Engineering analogy
- Emphasis on creativity
- Shifting & sharing
- Policing as a knowledgeinformed craft

- Tends to be generic
- Universal solutions
- Medical analogy
- Emphasis on fidelity
- No comparable
- Policing as a scientific profession

Causes for concern

- Evidence-based everything
- POP got marginalized by community policing in the 1990s
- EBP & Big Data threaten to marginalize it now
